# Reading


Reading is important and we really value your support with this at home. We ask that you listen to your child read aloud at least 3x a week, even if your child is a confident reader!

Please record this in your child's reading diary as this is used to monitor reading progress over the year. In year 1 when they read at home they move around the Reading Race Track.

Your child will always have a reading scheme book (or free reader) matched to their ability. They will also have a library book of their choice - this does not have to be read aloud to you - It is to share and enjoy!

For younger children (up to reading scheme Stage 9) it is important that they read the text **three** times to improve fluency.

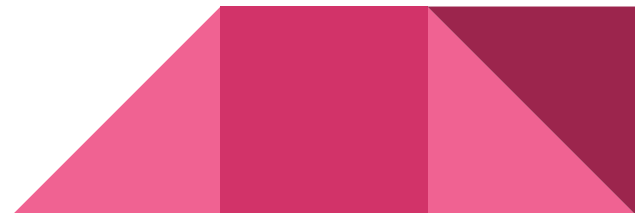
# Assessments

Year 2 Phonics Screener-November this year only



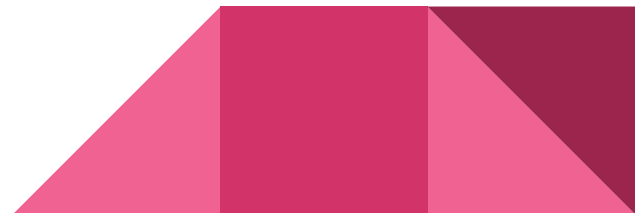
# Food and drink
