We expect children to wear the correct PE kit:

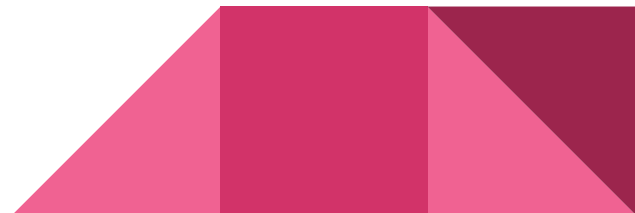
- Black or navy shorts/joggers/leggings.
