We expect children to wear the correct PE kit:

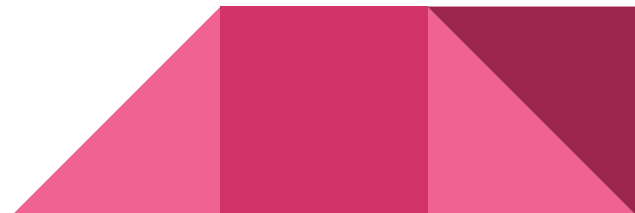
- Black or navy shorts/joggers/leggings.

Reading

Reading is important and we really value your support with this at home. We ask that you listen to your child read aloud every day and record at least 3x a week, even if your child is a confident reader!

Please record this in your child's reading diary as this is used to monitor reading progress over the year.

Your child will always have a reading scheme book or free reader matched to their ability. They will also have a library book of their choice - this does not have to be read aloud to you - it is to share and enjoy!
