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Dear Families,

As the end of Term 5 draws to a close, I thought I would write to let you know important information for Term 6. Thank you for following our guidelines this term. All children return to school on **Monday 7th June**. Any parents on the school site must continue to wear a mask.

Organisation of classes

All year groups will continue to be taught in their year group classrooms. There will now be two 'bubbles':

- Bubble 1: YR, Y1, Y2, Y3
- Bubble 2: Y4, Y5, Y6

Arrival at school for pupils

From Monday 7th June, all children will arrive at school by **8.55am** (as we used to do pre-covid). School gates will open at 8.45am and parents are responsible for ensuring their child enters the school gates safely.

- Children in Bubble 1 (YR, Y1, Y2, Y3) will arrive via the KS1 side gate or bottom gate and enter the school via either the KS1 side door or classroom doors for YR and Y1.
- Children in Bubble 2 (Y4, Y5, Y6) will arrive via the KS2 side gate or bottom gate and enter the school via the KS2 side door.

Car park drop off will be available in the mornings as usual from 8.45am. Members of staff on duty here will ensure children walk from the car to the correct entrance.

School leaving times

From Monday 7th June, the school day will end at **3.15pm** for all children (as we used to do pre-covid). School gates will be open at 3.10pm and parents may enter the site and wait for children to be dismissed.

- Year R: Parents wait and collect from outside EYFS classroom door.
- Year 1: Parents wait and collect from outside Y1 classroom door.
- Year 2: Parents wait outside KS1 side door along the wall. Wait here until children are dismissed from this door.
- Year 3: Parents wait outside the KS1 side gate. Wait here until children are dismissed from the Y3 classroom door.
- Year 4,5,6: Parents wait safely either directly outside the KS2 side door or along the path/KS2 gate.

No vehicle access to the site from 2.55pm-3.30pm. School car park gates will be closed. (PTO...)

PE Kits

PE kits will continue to be worn to school on PE days. This term we have noticed children wearing a range of clothes on PE days. From Term 6, children will be expected to wear sensible PE kits as outlined on the school website:

- Plain Shorts or PE skirt
- Plain T Shirt - preferably white
- Track suit or sweatshirt for outdoor work
- Trainers (also stud boots for football/rugby are allowed but not essential)
- Bare feet or black daps for indoor work

Breakfast Club/WACI

These clubs will continue as usual however children will not need to bring their own toys/games.

Lunchboxes

If your child is bringing a packed lunch to school, please ensure your child has a healthy balance of foods. We would suggest a sandwich (or similar), crisps, fruit/veg, yoghurt, chocolate/biscuit treat. This term we have noticed a number of children mainly eating sweet treats at lunchtime.

Thank you for helping to keep our school community healthy and safe. We will of course keep you updated if there are any other developments. I wish you a happy (and hopefully sunny) half term break together.
