Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it, Bin it, Kill it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands. Tissues will be made available throughout the workplace.</p> <p>To help reduce the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) reminding everyone of the public health advice - https://www.publichealth.hscni.net/news/covid-19-coronavirus</p> <p>All users of the centre entering the building must ensure temperature is taken. Thermometer located at main reception. If customers temperature is greater than 37.7C then that customer cannot enter the building and must return home and seek medical advise.</p> <p>Pre swim shower – Located on poolside.</p> <p>No main showers in changing rooms</p>
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
